#### Dear Parents,

Your child is learning that the letters k and ck at the end of a word (or syllable) sound exactly the same. It's important to learn which to use. We're also working on the soundalike spellings ch and tch. Again, it's important to know which is right. This will help, though there are exceptions to each rule:

- Spell it ck if it follows a short vowel.
- Spell it k (or ke) if it does not follow a short vowel.
- Spell it tch if it follows a short vowel.
- Spell it ch if it does not follow a short vowel.

Help your child apply these spelling rules to sort the words in this activity. First, discuss the directions with your child. Then guide your child through the activity, letting your child do as much as possible without your help. Notice that there is one extra blank to be filled for each spelling pattern. Help your child fill in this blank. Then check each word against the rule it illustrates.

Have your child find more words ending in ck or k and ending in tch or ch. Your child could write the words on small pieces of paper. Together sort the words into sets with like spelling patterns. Try it!


