Many of you are receiving an auto generated email about library book due dates. For the time being please store your child's library book in a very safe place at home where it will not be lost amongst your own personal book collection.

As a reminder the three elementary school libraries <u>do not</u> charge overdue fines. We do charge for lost or damaged books.

On Friday 3/13 I sent out individual emails through our library system to students (and their parents) if the child had a book or books a month or more overdue or owe money for a lost or damaged book. I put \$ amounts for each book on these notices even if they are not damaged because if the book(s) is a month or more overdue I have no way to know if it is lost or damaged or if the child is simply forgetting to return the book(s). When the child brings in their book(s) that are a month or more overdue I remove the fine as long as the book(s) is in good condition (no damage).
